- Supervising Athletic Trainer must be a NTATS member prior to application deadline
- A one page essay (no more than 500 words) on what Athletic Training means to you and how Athletic Training will help you meet your professional goals
- Turn in your essay and recommendation letter via the Application Google form
- Must provide proof of enrollment to a College or University to ntats.at@gmail.com before receiving your check if selected
